Exhibit Space:

Each standard booth is 10' X 10'. Draped back is 8' high; sides 3'. Each booth includes a 8' draped table & 2 chairs. Electricity is available at each booth. Cost is \$575.00.

Reservation also includes:

Additional lighting, decorating, furniture, carpet and signage are available from the decorator service, Corvallis. Exhibitors will receive a decorator reservation form in exhibitors package. Decorators personnel will also be on site during set up.

Conference Schedule:

Seminars will be presented in the conference area throughout the open hours of the Event. The location of the entrance and food court in relationship to the conference area allows for plenty of exhibit area flow through traffic throughout the day.

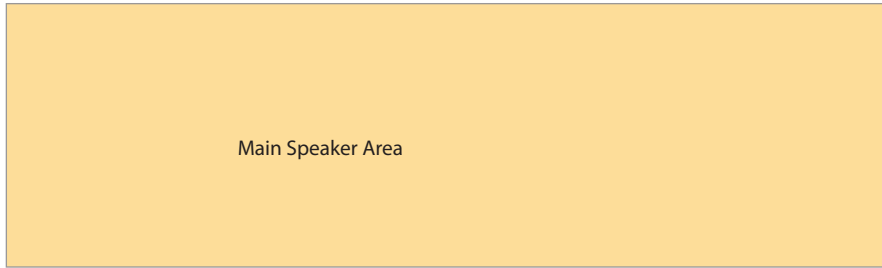

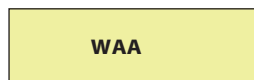
